



Desktop Control Unit Quick Installation Guide v 0.1

1. Connecting Desktop Control Unit

- a. Connect provided cable to Desktop Control Unit
- b. Connect provided cable to Secure KVM
- c. Power ON Secure KVM after connecting the Desktop Control Unit to the Secure KVM
- d. Once connected to the Desktop Control Unit the Secure KVM front panel is disabled and will NOT function
- e. Change Secure KVM channels using Desktop Control Unit
- f. Continue to turn CAC On or Off from Secure KVM

2. Q&A

- a. Q: My Secure KVM only has 2 ports, why does the Desktop Control Unit have 4 buttons?
A: Only the first 2 buttons will work with a connected 2 port Secure KVM unit
- b. Q: Can I turn the CAC On or Off from the Desktop Control Unit
A: The Desktop Control Unit only shows the CAC switch status - it cannot turn it On or Off
- c. Q: After the Desktop Control Unit is connected to the Secure KVM, all the Secure KVM keys stops functioning
A: Once the Desktop Control Unit is connected, the Desktop Control Unit will take over control

3. Caution

- a. The Desktop Control Unit is tamper proof, opening the Desktop Control Unit enclosure will make the Desktop Control Unit inoperable
- b. Connecting a tampered Desktop Control Unit to a functioning Secure KVM unit will make the Secure KVM inoperable
